

N95 Mask Decontamination Request

The staff at the Johnson County Sheriff's Office Criminalistics Laboratory (JCSOCL) is providing Ultraviolet Germicidal Irradiation (UVGI) decontamination of used N95 masks. Masks processed at the JCSOCL will be subjected to UVC light. This process will take approximately one hour, but may vary due to quantity. The JCSOCL cannot guarantee the effectiveness of this process; each user should consider the risk of reusing single use PPE. Mask decontamination is provided by appointment only.

You will be contacted via email/phone to confirm your drop off time. Masks must be packaged according to the below listed guidelines.

- Each mask must be permanently labeled with the name of the wearer (marked directly on the mask). Ensure sufficient labeling exists to return the mask to the original owner.
- Each mask must be placed in an individual paper bag labeled with the name of the wearer. Fold the paper bag several times to prevent reopening. Do not use staples.
- The paper bags must be placed collectively in a secondary container (i.e. Rubbermaid tote)
- Soiled or masks with cosmetics on them are not good candidates for decontamination.
